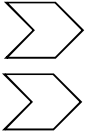

Grand Jury

Mission Statement:

The Grand Jury serves as an independent agent empowered to help improve the overall functioning of governmental entities within the county, including city and county governments, schools and special districts. The Penal Code requires the Grand Jury to inspect all law enforcement custodial facilities within the county, including any operated by the state.

Service Description:

The Grand Jury is a judicially appointed body of 19 adult citizens. Selection and appointment is accomplished by the Superior Court. The activities of the Jury are supervised by the Presiding Judge of the Grand Jury. The Grand Jury reviews the day to day operational aspects of the county and municipalities and special districts within the county and reports its findings in public reports. Reports include recommendations to improve the deficiency and effectiveness of local government. Investigations may be stimulated by citizen complaints or by other means. Reports are made public via press releases and on the Jury's website at www.civilgrandjury.com. Copies of the final report of each grand jury are also available at the branches of the county library and state archives.

Major Accomplishments in 2013-14:

- Responded to 22 Citizen Complaints as of February 18, 2014.
- Inspected 6 custodial facilities in the county.
- Looked into the activities of 6 special districts, all three cities in the county, 6 county departments, 5 school districts and school related organizations as of February 18, 2014.
- Posted all Reports and Responses from the 2012-2013 Grand Jury on the Jury's website.
- Published and distributed hard copies of the Consolidated Final Report, including all Reports and Responses to them of the 2012-2013 Grand Jury (in process as of February 18, 2014).
- Conducted multiple self-initiated investigations regarding various aspects of local government entities.
- Completed on-line ethics training by 11 Jurors. The remaining Jurors completed their ethics

training during the 2012-2013 Jury year.

Objectives & Performance Measures for 2014-15:

Objective:

Respond to Citizen Complaints.

Performance Measures:

- Acknowledge all citizens complaints within one week of receipt.
- Release subject area reports as dictated by significant findings and recommendations for change related to citizen complaints.

Objective:

Inspect custodial facilities.

Performance Measures:

- Inspect all county facilities by June 30, 2014.
- Release Reports on any significant findings with recommendations for improvement.

Objective:

Monitor the general efficiency and effectiveness of local government entities.

Performance Measures:

- Review management and finances of all three cities in the county.
- Review at least 5 special districts.
- Monitor school district responses to the state budget for indicators of efficiency and educational excellence preservation.
- Release subject area reports at various times if significant areas of concern are noted and post them on the Grand Jury website.

Objective:

Consolidated Final Report.

Performance Measures:

- Publish a Consolidated Final Report of the proceedings of the 2013-2014 Grand Jury, including all subject area Reports and Responses to them by December 31, 2014.
