#### **Community Services and Supports (CSS):**

• Weekly Insight Respite Center meetings are occurring so that we can implement the Insight Respite Center as soon as we have a contract approved by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors. Nancy Callahan has created a Work Plan to guide us through this process.

#### • Housing:

o Housing Choice Voucher (formally known as Section 8) waiting list is open. Pre-Applications can be downloaded at <a href="www.rhasnc.org">www.rhasnc.org</a> or call (888) 671-0220.

#### **Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI):**

- Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) has rewritten the PEI Regulations. The regulations are still with the legal department.
- CMHDA (County Mental Health Director Association) is working with the MHSOAC and the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) to allow PEI funds to be put in the Prudent Reserve.

Programs under contract/being implemented: Suicide Prevention, Senior Outreach, 211 Nevada County, Homeless Outreach, First Responder Training, Latino Outreach, Forensic Outreach, Second Step, Early Intervention for Youth at Risk, What's Up? Wellness Checks, Truckee Wellness Center and mentoring programs.

#### **Capital Facility (CF):**

• SB 82: Investment in Mental Health Wellness grant was released in December with Grant applications due January 22, 2014. Nevada County submitted a grant application to establish a Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU) at Sierra Nevada Memorial Hospital. We requested \$500,000. We have not heard yet if we are awarded or not.

#### **Innovations**:

 Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) has rewriting the Innovation Regulations. The regulations are with the Department of Health Care Service's legal department for final review.
