

# **Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Report**

## **11/01/13**

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### **MHSA (Mental Health Services Act) Annual Progress Report for FY 11/12 and Annual Plan Update for FY 13/14:**

- Annual Plan Update for FY 13/14 and Annual Progress Report is done for FY 11/12 and has been posted for public comment period from October 21<sup>st</sup> through November 20<sup>th</sup>. The Public Hearing will be on December 6<sup>th</sup> at the Mental Health Board meeting.

### **Community Services and Supports (CSS):**

- **Respite Care:**
  - Community planning process is under way to utilize SB 82 Triage Personnel grant funds to fund staff for a Respite Care program.
  - Looking at multiple funding streams to implement a Respite Care program
- **Housing:**
  - The Summer's Haven Program/Supportive Housing Program (SHP) is being implemented. We currently have ten units under a master lease with multiple applications in process. The barrier to date is finding landlords that will master lease with Nevada County Housing Development Corporation (NCHDC). We are in the process of renewing the grant for this program.
  - The Winters' Haven House is full with five tenants.

### **Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI):**

- The Board of Supervisors supported the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District (TTUSD) Wellness Program contract on October 8, 2013. The contract is for \$50,000 to support a Wellness Centers at Truckee High and North Tahoe high and individualized wellness programming at Sierra high. The centers serve as hubs for high school students to talk to caring adults, connect to community resources and learn new skills to develop sustainable wellness practices. This program is a collaborative project between the TTUSD, Placer and Nevada County Behavioral Health Department, Community Collaborative of Tahoe Truckee partners and youth designed to help high school students access a broad spectrum of mental health services.
- Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) is reviewing and rewriting the PEI Regulations. Michele Violett is part of the CMHDA workgroup providing feedback to MHSOAC.

Programs under contract/being implemented: Suicide Prevention, Senior Outreach, 211 Nevada County, Homeless Outreach, First Responder Training, Latino Outreach, Forensic Outreach, Second Step, Early Intervention for Youth at Risk, What's Up? Wellness Checks and mentoring programs.

### **Capital Facility (CF):**

- Respite Care project is being written into the SB 82: 2013 Triage Personnel Grant. A Program Manager is looking at program options and the cost associated with the different options.
- SB 82: 2013 Triage Personnel grant has been released. The second grant that allows for the building of structures has not been released yet. It is anticipated that Respite Care or

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Crisis Support unit or Crisis Residential facility will be supported with the second part of the SB 82 grant.

#### **Innovations:**

- Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) is reviewing and rewriting the Innovation Regulations. Michele Violetta is part of the CMHDA workgroup providing feedback to MHSOAC.

#### **Workforce Education and Training (WET)-**

- Our Voices Matter continues to meet every month.
- Training:
  - Mental Health First Aid trainings had 35 (21 regular class and 14 youth class) participants in the last two classes
  - Mental Health First Aid: Upcoming trainings-November 7<sup>th</sup>, January 22<sup>nd</sup>, March 14<sup>th</sup>, April 30<sup>th</sup>

#### **Technological Needs (TN): Anasazi**

- Turning Point Training has started, wave one of three is finished
- Consumers are able to get a copy of their mental health records now.
- Kings View contract was approved by the Board of Supervisors on October 8, 2013.
