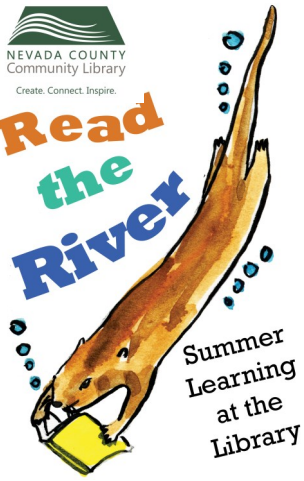


Read the River
