SUBJECT

FACILITIES JURISDICTION

POLICY

The Nevada County Sheriff's Office will have primary jurisdiction over calls for service at various Nevada County owned facilities located within the incorporated cities of the county pursuant to the following procedure.

PURPOSE

To define responsibility for calls for service at county owned facilities located within the city limits of Nevada City, Grass Valley and Town of Truckee.

PROCEDURE

- A.. The Nevada City Police Department shall have primary jurisdiction for all calls for service including all alarm and crime reports occurring on and inside buildings of all County owned/occupied facilities located on property within the city limits of Nevada City, including parking lots and unimproved lands thereof, with the following exceptions in which the Sheriff's Office will handles primary jurisdiction.
 - a. Crimes originating/occurring within the Nevada City Courthouse, including the court holding area, basement and courthouse annex.
 - b. Crimes originating/occurring within the Eric Rood Administrative Center.
 - c. Crimes originating/occurring within the Wayne Brown Correctional Facility (WBCF) with the exception of when arrestees of the Nevada City Police Department bring contraband into the WBCF discovered during the arrest/booking process.

- d. Crimes in progress observed by sworn Sheriff's personnel.
- B. The Grass Valley Police Department has primary jurisdiction for all calls for service and crimes occurring in or to county facilities located within the city limits of Grass Valley and any adjacent land or parking lots.
- C. The Sheriff's Office has primary jurisdiction for all calls for service and crimes occurring in or to any county owned property within the city limits of the Town of Truckee. This includes but is not limited to the Joseph Center, library, court holding facility, and jail.
- D. The above notwithstanding, the nearest available unit will respond to any in progress emergency at a county owned facility or when mutual aid is requested by the primary jurisdiction or otherwise authorized by the on duty supervisor.
