2019 POINT IN TIME COUNT RESULTS


410 People experiencing homelessness counted on January 24th, 2019

On January 24th, 2019, the Homeless Resource Council of the Sierras - representing the joint Continuum of Care for Placer and Nevada Counties - conducted a Point In Time Count to measure the number of individuals and families experiencing homelessness in our community.

Experiencing chronic homelessness: currently homeless for a year or more or 4+ episodes of homelessness in the past 3 years totaling 365 days or more and have a disabling condition.

The 2019 Point In Time results demonstrated a 11% increase as compared to 2017. However, various factors can affect these results - such as weather, location of the event, etc.
