

ORDER OF THE NEVADA COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER

**ORDER RESCINDING THE MAY 21, 2020, AMENDED ORDER REGARDING
CLARIFICATION OF GOVERNOR'S AND STATE HEALTH OFFICER'S "STAY-AT-HOME"
ORDER AS RELATED TO LODGING FACILITIES**

DATE OF ORDER: June 12, 2020

WHEREAS, in response to the rapid spread of COVID-19 in California, the Governor of the State of California issued Executive Order N-33-20 on March 19, 2020, directing all residents to heed the current State public health directives, including that all individuals living in the State of California stay at their home or at their place of residence until further notice; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2020, the Nevada County Public Health Officer issued an Order entitled: *Clarification of Governor's and State Health Officer's "Stay at Home" Order as Related to Lodging Facilities*, which was subsequently amended on May 21, 2020, to provide further clarity on the operation of lodging and short-term lodging facilities in Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) recently issued *Industry Guidance: Hotels, Lodging, and Short Term Rentals* ("Guidance"), effective June 12, 2020, to promote safe, clean hotel, lodging, and short term rental environments for workers and customers, accessible at <https://covid19.ca.gov/pdf/guidance-hotels-lodging-rentals.pdf>; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed the CDPH Guidance, and considering local epidemiological data including cases per 100,000 population, rate of test positivity, local preparedness to support a health care surge, vulnerable populations, contract tracing, and testing, the Nevada County Health Officer finds that the CDPH Guidance provides effective and sufficient measures for hotel, lodging, and short term rental workers and customers in Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, in light of the newly issued CDPH Guidance for the operation of hotel, lodging, and short term rental industries, the Nevada County Health Officer finds that his June 12, 2020, *Clarification of Governor's and State Health Officer's "Stay at Home" Order as Related to Lodging Facilities*, may be rescinded.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the authority under Health and Safety Code sections 101030, et seq., and 120100, et seq., and Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations section 2501, that the Nevada County Public Health Officer's May 21, 2020, *Clarification of Governor's and State Health Officer's "Stay at Home" Order as Related to Lodging Facilities* is hereby rescinded.
