Breakout Group Notes

- **CHILD CARE:** Table within the guidance that breaks down PPE and supplies that are required
Children under 2 – advise NOT to wear a mask
Workforce is **required** to wear a mask
Gloves – for serving food, cleaning supplies, dealing with trash – not for children for the work force.
Always wash your hands, choose this over hand sanitizer whenever possible
Create a plan for COVID – simplify but make it inclusive. How to source PPE, train employees, accommodate new requirements appropriately. Plan is NOT required by county, its only to benefit you and your business
CLEANING – open windows for fresh air flow, high touch areas, create cleaning schedule to cover all disinfectant needs.

Healthy habits – wash hands before eating, after bathroom. Teaching kids not to touch their face and mouth. Make it fun! Turn it into a game.

Utilize different entrances so that parents can be spread out when they arrive close to the same time.

Limit interactions with multiple people

Install hand sanitizers where it is convenient and most utilized

Health screenings – **required**, use NO touch thermometer

Consider after school and pick up times and how those will be sanitized

Recommend smaller groups of children whenever possible

Discuss options like out door time and encourage 6ft separation naturally
Stager indoor and outdoor play between groups so that sanitization can occur easily
Meal times – spread tables out and encourage physical distancing
Do not share food or trade food

Questions:

Q: What is the county stance on masks with children?

County does not have any mandates towards masks at all. This guidance states that masks are required for the childcare workforce.

Q: Is there a list of businesses that are mandated to do screenings? Summer Camps?

Childcare does have the requirements for screenings. Other industries such as camps are not as specific.

Q. Is there a Maximum number of kids in a facility

10 children per group, infants is 6. Not within guidance specifically but can be found

Q. Running into children who go to different care centers throughout the week – part time at 2 different centers. Do we have any guidance or consideration on such things?

It is not likely for the county to come out with specific guidance or restrictions on that. The county has typically aligned with the state and is not likely to restrict further than the state. **LOOKING INTO FURTHER

Q. Teachers of summer camp programs, are face shields ok to offer in place masks?

The shield is not a replacement for a face covering. The shield is more protective of what is coming at you. The face covering is how you can protect what comes out of you and limits spread from you

Q. should the 49er fun park operate at 25% of normal or how many I can keep apart?

There isn't a specific mandate for family entertainment centers for max occupancy. It does say to adjust maximum occupancy rules to limit the number of people to allow for physical distancing. Limiting occupancy in certain areas of the park would be a great way to meet the intent of this guidance.

Q. are birthday parties, etc. not allowed yet?

no parties yet as gatherings of many households are not allowed.
