  - We are now in stage 3 of California's plan for phasing back into business. Guidance aimed to ensure customer and employee safety and decrease risk to all parties. The State is working with business sectors to develop guidelines which are handed over to the Counties to determine when sectors will open. State determines the How; County determines the When.
  - It is recognized that businesses need some time prior to re-opening to make modifications and adjustments. The County plans to post a revised reopening plan this Thursday.
  - There has been a recent uptick in Covid-19 cases. Some of these recent cases have been preventable.
  - Hopefully we will be able to familiarize ourselves with the guidelines geared toward our specific sectors.

Caleb Dardick highlighted some of the information on the state's guide for personal services. The document covers practical sanitation practices that apply to these industries: For instance, employees, and in some cases, clients to be required to wear masks. Nail salons should have air circulation/venting systems in place, etc.
- Business Plans
  - Many business owners have asked if they need to turn in their business plans. Business plans do NOT have to be submitted in writing to the County; however, they should be available to the public.

- 72 Hour down time for STRs – Can the cleaner be in the middle of that.
- Duvet cleaning

A: Amy Irani addressed and shared that there are some EPA recommended solutions for cloth covered furnishings. Surface must be sprayed down wet and allowed to dry. Suggested to wash linens, towels etc. as much as possible in sanitizing solutions and dry in high heat. For hard surfaces, use a solution of 1/3 C of bleach to a Gal of water and let sit for 60 seconds. In some situations, disposable coverings may be appropriate. For carpet and fabric, there are a couple that are highly used and recommended products: Purell multi-surface disinfectant and Sani-spray.

Q: Is there guidance for situations in which multiple businesses are sharing offices/workplaces.

Q: RE - Family Fun Parks/Centers

A: There isn't a specific mandate for family entertainment centers for max occupancy. It does say to adjust maximum occupancy rules to limit the number of people to allow for physical distancing. Limiting occupancy in certain areas of the park would be a great way to meet the intent of this guidance.

Q: Any information regarding hot tubs/saunas?

A: Hot tubs/saunas cannot open at this time.

Q: Several questions regarding catering/weddings

A: Ceremonies allowed with physical distancing. Receptions are not allowed at this time.

Q: Is there any advice for business that have clients with chemical sensitivities?

A: It is recommended to alert clients/guests about the type of chemical solution being used before they enter the establishment.
