Course Description

The Cellebrite Mobile Forensics Fundamentals (CMFF) course is a Two-Day (14 hours) Entry/Beginner level program designed for investigators to learn about mobile devices, understand general ideas of the forensic process, learn how to seize devices, and review extracted device data provided by examiners. Participants are introduced to baseline concepts and prerequisite knowledge to understand issues surrounding the handling of mobile devices as evidence. This class does NOT include conducting extractions.

The CMFF is the starting point for first responders, investigators and Crime Scene Investigations staff tasked with identifying and seizing mobile devices for data acquisition. CMFF is ideal for data extraction team members, technically savvy investigators, digital forensic examiners, arresting officers, internal affairs investigators, evidence technicians, and IT staff.
